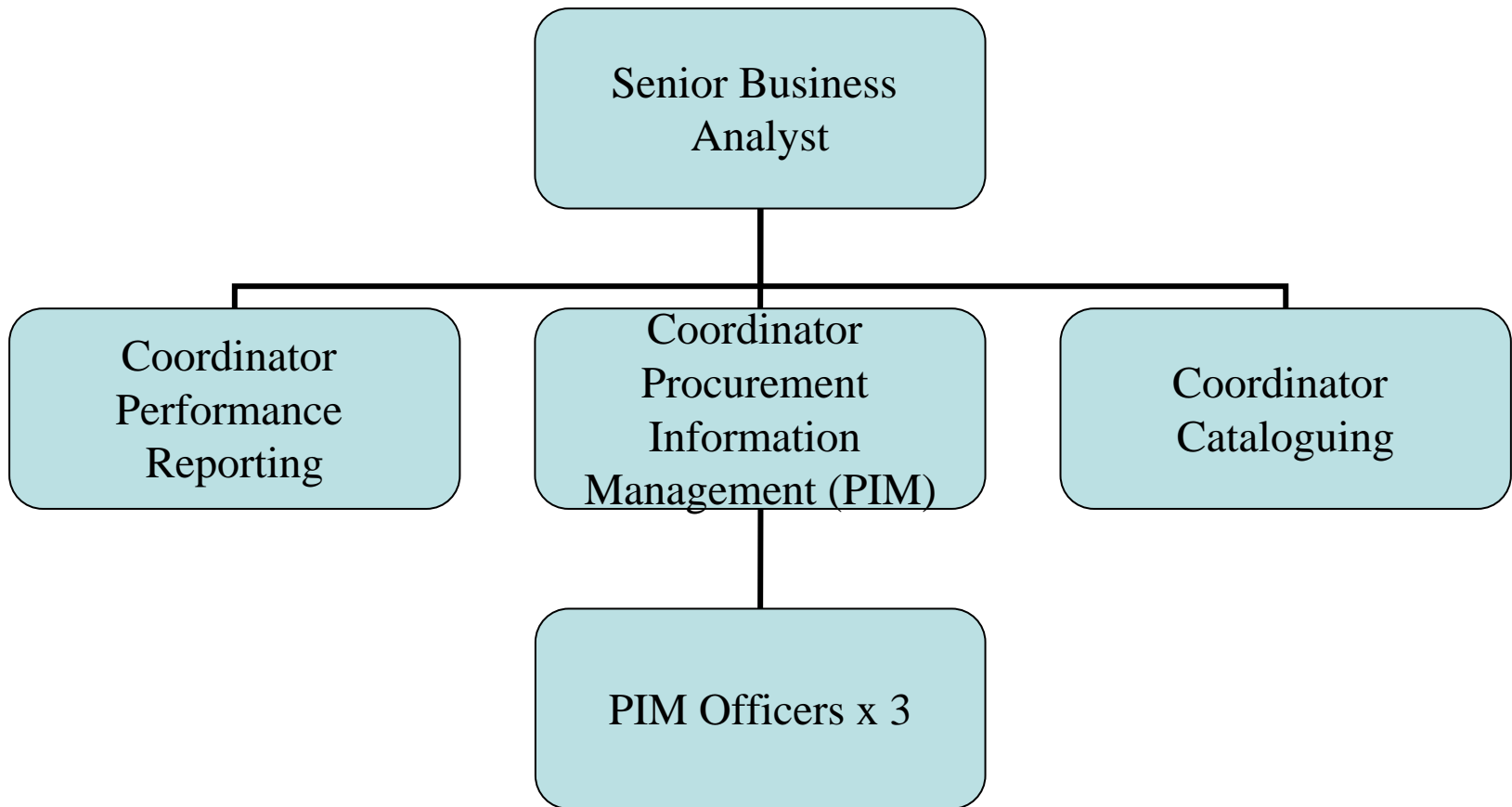

What is the National Product Catalogue?

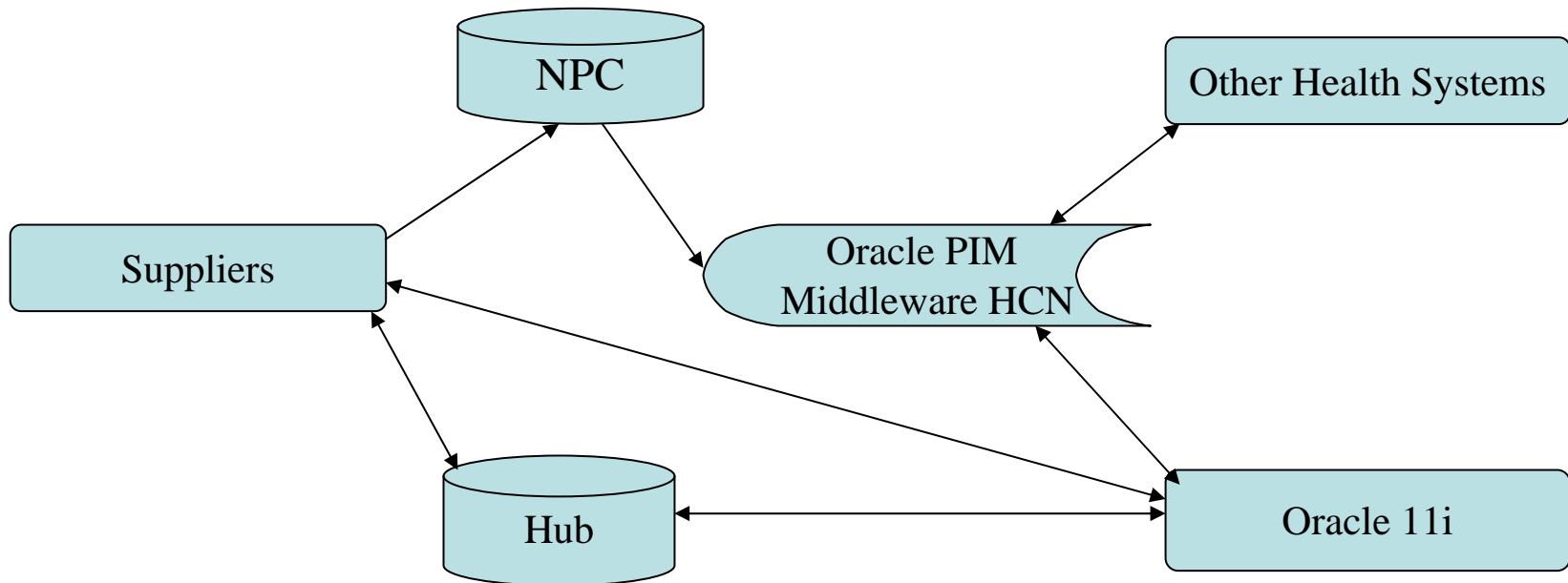
A single electronic source of product and pricing data with synchronization between supplier to GS1 and GS1 to purchasing systems:

- Medicines
- Medical devices
- Healthcare
- Non-medical
- Hosted by GS1



E-procurement

Central data management with data synchronized with suppliers. System to system transactions.





Australian Medicines Terminology

AMT is an extension to the Systematized Nomenclature of Medicine-Clinical Terms (SNOMED)

Current Version - Release 1.2:

- 3800 medicines from the ARTG - PBS items
- Schedule 8 non-PBS items



Global Trade Item Number - GTIN – Barcode

Unique identification of trade items at package and brand level

- ❑ Current status WA Health
 - (CH2 and Symbion products)
 - 70% of pharmacy products have GTINS
